



DivorceCare Program Design and Find a Group

The Find a Group search tool is provided as a free promotional resource to local churches. In order for your group to qualify for a free listing, your group must operate the way DivorceCare was designed. This ensures that people searching for a group online will be connected to groups similar to what is described on the DivorceCare website.

Here are the key elements of the DivorceCare Program Design:

- **All 13 session topics are presented**

Each topic is carefully crafted to meet the needs of people facing separation or divorce.

NOTE: Without affecting your eligibility for listing your group, you may shorten your 13-week cycle to a minimum of 11-week cycle by combining a couple of session topics and extending your schedule an extra 30-minutes to allow for adequate discussion time on each session topic. You may also extend beyond the 13-week cycle to incorporate an Orientation/Registration Session and/or Celebration Session at the end of the cycle. Feel free to contact us for assistance in customizing your online listing.

- **Each session lasts at least 90 minutes**

To insure adequate time for all the DivorceCare session activities, your DivorceCare group should meet for at least 90 minutes. A two-hour length is preferable.

- **Each participant receives a DivorceCare workbook**

Each participant will interact with the workbook during each weekly session and at home during the week. It is essential that each person in your group have a personal copy.

Only groups that operate in compliance with the DivorceCare Program Design qualify for a listing on the Find a Group search engine and access to online session videos. Use of the DivorceCare name and trademark is limited to groups that operate according to the DivorceCare Program Design.
